

## **Bursary Scheme 2018**

The Norwich Canoe Club Bursary Scheme is aimed at people whose participation in Canoeing is inhibited because of their financial situation.

Under this Bursary Scheme Norwich Canoe Club will offer free membership up to two juniors (under 18s) and to two adults per year that are unable to pay the membership fees.

The award of free membership will be reviewed at the end of its period December 31st 2017.

Norwich Canoe Club reserves the right to seek funding for the Bursary Scheme.

### **QUALIFICATIONS**

All applicants must state in writing why their participation in Canoeing is inhibited because of their financial situation.

All applicants must declare if they have or are receiving financial assistance from any organisation or bodies to assist them in training or experience of a sport. This applies both before and during the period of awarded free membership.

Any change in an applicant's personal financial position must be communicated to the Club Chair 2018 and could result in them being ineligible for any further award of free membership and they may be expected to pay any membership fees pro rata for the period left from the change until the end of the awarded membership period (December 31st 2018).

### **CONSIDERATION OF APPLICATIONS**

Applications will be considered on merit and with discretion, by the NCC Bursary Panel and/or Whitlingham Boathouses panel whose decision is final. Neither the NCC Bursary Panel nor the Whitlingham Boathouses panel will enter into discussion or correspondence as to why particular applicants were or were not successful. In the event that the NCC Bursary Panel does not consider any applications to be appropriate, then Norwich Canoe Club reserves the right not to make any award.
